3.61 FRAUD AND CORRUPT PRACTICES

- 3.61.1 The bidder and their respective officers, employees, agents and advisers shall observe the highest standard of ethics during the Selection Process. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this RFP, the IPGL shall reject a Proposal without being liable in any manner whatsoever to the bidder, if it determines that the bidder has, directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice (collectively the "Prohibited Practices") in the Selection Process. In such an event, the IPGL shall, without prejudice to its any other rights or remedies, forfeit and appropriate the Bid Security or Performance Security, as the case may be, as mutually agreed genuine pre-estimated compensation and damages payable to the IPGL for, inter alia, time, cost and effort of the IPGL, in regard to the RFP, including consideration and evaluation of such bidder's Proposal.
- 3.61.2 Without prejudice to the rights of the IPGL under Clause 1.1 hereinabove and the rights and remedies which the IPGL may have under the LOA or the Agreement, if a bidder, is found by the IPGL to have directly or indirectly or through an agent, engaged or indulged in any corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice during the Selection Process, or after the issue of the LOA or the execution of the Agreement, such bidder shall not be eligible to participate in any tender or RFP issued by the IPGL during a period of 2 (two) years from the date such bidder, is found by the IPGL to have directly or through an agent, engaged or indulged in any corrupt practice, fraudulent practice, coercive practice, undesirable practice or restrictive practice, as the case may be.
